ORDER IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner (“OCCC”) issues this Order Imposing Administrative Penalty against Texas Cash & Title LLC (“Texas Cash & Title”).¹

Statement of Facts and Law

Texas Cash & Title is a credit services organization licensed to act as a credit access business under Chapter 393 of the Texas Finance Code. Texas Cash & Title operates under master file number 1400051640 at one licensed location, under license number 152025. Texas Cash & Title’s compliance officer is Curtis Coleman, and its designated contact address is 320 East Main Street, Atlanta, Texas 75551.

A credit access business must file quarterly and annual reports with the Consumer Credit Commissioner (“Commissioner”).² A credit access business must submit its quarterly and annual reports on or before the following dates:

- 1st quarter report – April 30;
- 2nd quarter report – July 31;
- 3rd quarter report – October 31; and
- 4th quarter and annual report – January 31.³

If a credit access business fails to timely file its quarterly or annual reports within four quarters of failing to timely file a previous report, the OCCC may

impose an administrative penalty of \$500.00 for each licensed location.⁴ If a credit access business fails to file its quarterly report three or more times within four quarters of the second offense, the OCCC may impose an administrative penalty of \$1,000.00 for each licensed location.⁵ Upon a fourth offense within four quarters of three or more offenses, the OCCC may seek the revocation of a business's license.⁶

On December 11, 2019, the OCCC issued an Order to File Timely and Accurate Quarterly and Annual Reports against Texas Cash & Title for failing to file its 2019 third quarter report. Texas Cash & Title has not yet filed its 2019 third quarter report, in violation of the Order to File Timely and Accurate Quarterly and Annual Reports.

Texas Cash & Title did not file its 2019 fourth quarter and annual reports with the Commissioner on or before January 31, 2020. Additionally, Texas Cash & Title did not timely file one or more of its reports within the four quarters preceding the 2019 4th quarter and annual reports.

Order

IT IS ORDERED that Texas Cash & Title LLC:

1. pay an administrative penalty in the amount of **\$500.00**, calculated as \$500.00 for Texas Cash & Title's one licensed location, within 30 days of service of this Order; and
2. file all delinquent reports, including 2019 third quarter, 2019 fourth quarter, and annual reports, within 30 days of service of this Order, if it has not already done so.

Credit access business quarterly and annual reports must be submitted through the OCCC's Application Licensing Examination and Compliance System (ALECS): alecs.occ.texas.gov. Instructions are available by clicking the "File Annual Report" button on the OCCC's home page, occ.texas.gov. A check made payable to 'Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner' may be mailed to 2601 N.

Response and Right to Request Hearing

If you request a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be set and conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code.⁸ If you fail to request a hearing by the deadline, this Order will be considered final and enforceable.⁹
